In 1911, Saint Louis University was founded by Fr. Seraphin Devesse, a priest of the order of the Congregatio Immaculati Cordis Mariae (CICM).

For over a hundred years, from a one-room elementary school in Baguio City for ten local boys, SLU has essentially grown to be one of the biggest universities in the Philippines that has been nurtured and molded by the CICM.
