INFORMATION FOR APPLICANTS

The Saint Louis University School of Medicine will start accepting applications for First Year Medicine for Academic Year 2021-2022 on January 18, 2021. All applications should be made online; the link will be made available at the SLU Website and on the SLU School of Medicine Facebook page.

The deadline for submission of application forms and other requirements is on February 26, 2021.

REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISSION

All applicants to the School of Medicine are screened by the Committee on Admissions. This committee, after a thorough study of all pertinent information, prepares and recommends a list of candidates who may be accepted for enrolment to First Year.

The following requirements have to be fulfilled before any applicant can be considered by the Committee on Admissions:

1. The applicant must be a holder of a Bachelor's Degree in Science or Arts or is expected to finish the course before the start of the academic year 2021-2022.
2. The applicant must fill up the online application form completely and accurately.
3. The applicant must submit the following in a long white folder, sent via courier to The Committee on Admissions, Office of the Dean, School of Medicine, Saint Louis University, Baguio City 2600, Philippines.
 - a) Original and photocopy of complete, latest transcript of records;
 - b) Certification from the Registrar of his or her University (if not indicated on the transcript) indicating the subject/s that he/she is taking in the second semester to complete the course;
 - c) Certification of General Weighted Average from the school for students who have graduated, and those currently enrolled

- d) Original copy and one (1) photocopy of the following:
- i. Certificate of Graduation
 - ii. National Medical Admission Test (NMAT) results
 - iii. Certificate of Live Birth printed on the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) security paper
 - iv. Certificate of Good Moral Character from the Office of Student Affairs
- e) Transfer credential or honorable dismissal (except SLU graduates);
- f) Two (2) recommendation letters from two (2) school officials (except SLU graduates);
- g) Three (3) 2x2 ID pictures taken within sixty (60) days as of the date of application.
4. All applicants are required to pay PHP 3,330 to cover application processing. For non-resident aliens, the fee is USD 580. Details on how to pay this application processing fee will follow;
5. The applicant will undergo an online interview via video conferencing for evaluation of communication skills and behavioral qualities. Details of the schedule of the interview will follow;
6. The applicant must not have been enrolled in any other medical school prior to application;
7. The applicant must have taken the National Medical Admission Test (NMAT) and met the percentile rank of 40 and above, as per CHED recommendation.

BASES FOR SELECTION

In the selection of applicants to the School of Medicine, the Committee on Admissions evaluates the following:

- Intellectual qualities as reflected in the B.S. or A.B. scholastic record. Applicants with more than nine (9) units failed/dropped in the undergraduate level may write a letter to the Committee on Admissions for reconsideration of the application.
- Results of the National Medical Admission Test (NMAT) must meet the percentile rank requirement of the university i.e. 40 and above.
- Evaluation results of the interview (communication skills, personality, motivation, etc.)
- Must not be more than 36 years of age on the first day of classes
- Must not have been convicted by a competent court of an offense involving moral turpitude
- Preferably a Filipino citizen. Applicants of international students will be considered in accordance with the policies of the Commission on Higher Education (CHED)

INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

In addition to the above, all foreign applicants must submit the following documents for visa purposes:

1. Two (2) original copies of the transcript of records duly authenticated by the Philippine Embassy in the student's country of origin.
2. Recommendation letters from two (2) school officials
3. Certificate of Eligibility for Admission (CEA) from CHED
4. Photocopy of passport data page and birth certificate authenticated by the Philippine Embassy in their country.
5. NBI clearance
6. Certificate of Graduation from a previous bachelor's degree
7. Certificate of having passed the English Proficiency Test

Applicants who are foreigners and/or graduates of foreign schools will be required to pay an "Out-of-State-Fee" in the amount of \$5,000.00 if accepted for admission. This "Out-of-State-Fee" is a one-time payment prior to enrolment and is not refundable.
