A.2 DOST-SEI-MERIT (RA 2067) – Awarded to students with high aptitude in Science and Mathematics; Willing to pursue careers in the fields of Science and Technology.

A.3 RA 7687 – Science and Technology Scholarship Act 1994; Provides for scholarships to talented and deserving families whose socio-economic status do not exceed the cut-off values of certain indicators; Qualifiers must pursue priority fields of study in the Basic Sciences, Engineering, other applied Sciences, and Science and Mathematics Teaching.

11. Saranay Ti Alumni Scholarship Program

Description:

The External Relations, Media Communications, and Alumni Affairs Office (ERMCAA), through the Guidance Center, offers the Scholarship Program to underprivileged and deserving incoming second-year Bachelor of Science in Secondary Education (BSED); Bachelor of Science in Elementary Education (BEED), and Bachelor of Science in Accountancy (BS Ac) students. The grantee shall be selected on the basis of scholastic performance, aptitude, capacity to meet the requirements and demands of the course, the parents' and/or guardian's capacity to financially support the education of the grantee.

12. SLU-Nursing Alumni Association

Description:

- The SLU - Nursing Alumni Association International Scholarship Program (SLU-NAAI), through the Guidance Center, provides financial assistance to underprivileged and deserving Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) students. The grantee is selected by the association who determines the recipient of the assistance on the basis of scholastic performance, aptitude, capacity to meet the requirements and demands of the course, the parents' and/or guardian's capacity to financially support the education of the grantee.

13. SLU-WOSTYN / SPIESSENS SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Description:

- Open for the following courses:

- Covers all the actual regular semestral and summer term tuition fees only and book allowance of PHP 1,000.00 per semester.
