University Libraries-Filipiniana Library

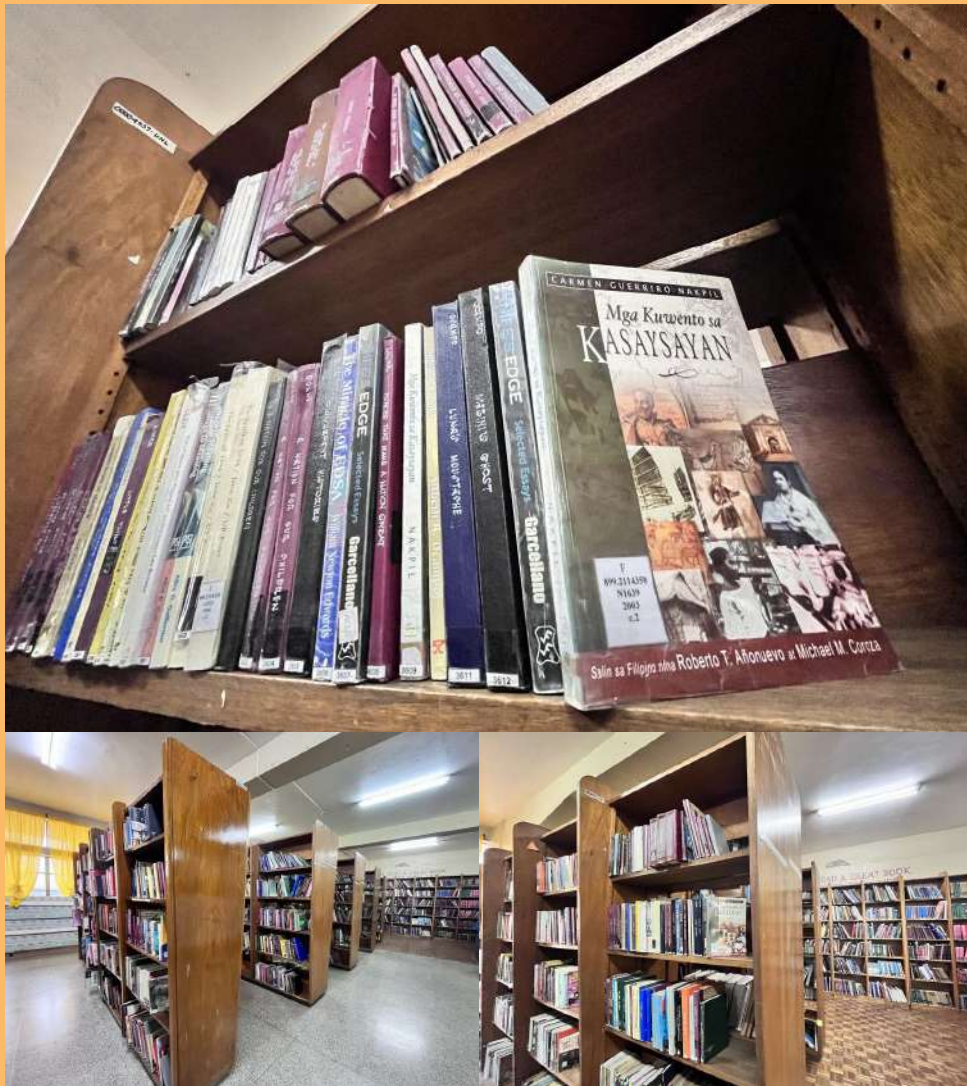
