


As a Center of Excellence in Teacher Education, Saint Louis University shared its on-going practices and prospects of teacher education during the second and third meetings on Promoting Teacher Education for Climate Change Education through Collaboration between Asian Centres of Excellence on Education for Sustainable Development. The second meeting was co-organized by Okayama University and Asia Pacific Cultural Centre for UNESCO in cooperation with UNESCO Bangkok and UNESCO Beijing and supported by Japan Society for the Promotion of Science. On the other hand, the third meeting, which was held with an International Conference on ESD in Mongolia 2022 was co-organized by the Mongolian National University of Education, National University of Mongolia, and Okayama University, in cooperation with UNESCO Bangkok and UNESCO Beijing and supported by Japan Society for Promotion of Science and BRI.

In-Net is the Internationalization Network of the ANTENA Project (EU-funded Erasmus+Project "Internationalization of Higher Education with the Philippine Network"), created in cooperation with ten universities from the Philippines, the Commission for Higher Education (CHED), two European universities, and an international association of universities and business schools. The aim of the project is to support HEIs in the Philippines strengthen their capacities to develop, implement and sustain their internationalization initiatives.

The founding members of In-Net are; Ateneo de Manila University, Benguet State University, Central Luzon State University, De La Salle University, Mindanao State University-Iligan Institute of Technology, Polytechnic University of the Philippines, Saint Louis University, University of the Philippines, University of San Carlos, Xavier University-Ateneo de Cagayan and the Commission on Higher Education.



The overarching purpose of **In-Net** is to organize and strengthen all internationalization efforts of Philippine universities through various strategies and projects. More specifically, it seeks to develop and consolidate best practices in teaching, research and social engagement.

In-Net's management and financial resources are supported by its member-IROs and by the Commission on Higher Education (CHED). The headquarters of the organization is housed in the International Affairs Staff Office at CHED. Any IRO of a legally constituted university in the Philippines may submit a request to the Network's Steering Committee to become a member.
