



PROJECT DAILY BREAD



The Project Daily Bread (PDB) was conceived in response to the cases that have come to the attention of the SLU Guidance Center regarding students who experience involuntary hunger.

The term "Project Daily Bread" was coined from the Lord's prayer taught by Jesus Christ to His disciples. PDB provides decent lunch meals for identified students who will be screened basically for involuntary hunger due to poverty.

The PDB was not implemented for the past two (2) academic years because of the lockdown and implementation of online classes due to the Covid-19 pandemic. However, the program resumed this academic year 2022-2023, out of the thirty three (33) former PDB scholars, nine are currently enrolled. From the nine (9) PDB scholars, five (5) of them decided to continue availing their free lunch meal.
