- Architecture: 2 laptops
- Chemical Engineering: 1 laptop, 1 Samsung Galaxy Tablet
- Civil Engineering: 2 laptops
- Electrical Engineering: 1 laptop, 1 iPad
- Electronics Engineering: 1 laptop, 1 iPad
- Geodetic Engineering: 1 laptop
- Industrial Engineering: 1 laptop and 1 iPad
- Mechanical Engineering: 1 laptop
- Mechatronics Engineering: 1 laptop
- Mining Engineering: 1 laptop

QUALIFICATIONS:

Open to SLU-SEA students who:

- are currently enrolled
- are in their 2nd or 3rd year level
- are residents of Baguio City, La Trinidad, Itogon, Sablan, Tuba, or Tublay (BLISTT)
- belong to a family whose combined monthly income is below PhP 40,000.00
- have not incurred any failing/INC/NC grade or dropped course in the previous semester
- do not have access to a laptop, tablet, or personal computer
- are not recipients of an active scholarship

MECHANICS:

Qualified students must fill-up an online form that requires them to:

- provide personal information
- upload a 2 x 2 inch ID picture
- upload valid proof of combined family income
- provide a copy of their grades in the previous term they were enrolled
- write a 150 to 200-word essay on the the need for the laptop or tablet

SELECTION:

- Based on the applicant responses in the online form, three qualified students per program will be selected by a committee made up of department heads.
- The final recipients will be selected from the students recommended by the department heads, by a committee composed of a SEA student representative, the SEA Associate Dean, and the SEA Dean.
- The laptop shall be considered the property of the recipient with the condition that he/she remains under any of the SEA programs of Saint Louis University until graduation. In the event that he/she transfers outside of SEA prior to graduation, the gadget shall be turned over to the next qualified recipient.

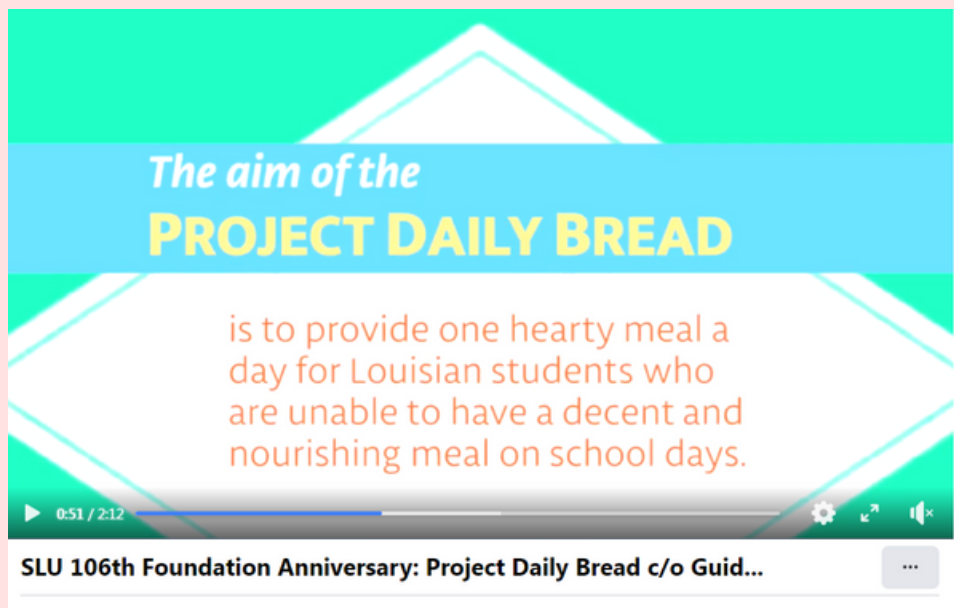

PROJECT DAILY BREAD



The Project Daily Bread (PDB) was conceived in response to the cases that have come to the attention of the SLU Guidance Center regarding students who experience involuntary hunger.

The term “Project Daily Bread” was coined from the Lord’s prayer taught by Jesus Christ to His disciples. PDB provides decent lunch meals for identified students who will be screened basically for involuntary hunger due to poverty.

The PDB was not implemented for the past two (2) academic years because of the lockdown and implementation of online classes due to the Covid-19 pandemic. However, the program resumed this academic year 2022-2023, out of the thirty three (33) former PDB scholars, nine are currently enrolled. From the nine (9) PDB scholars, five (5) of them decided to continue availing their free lunch meal.
