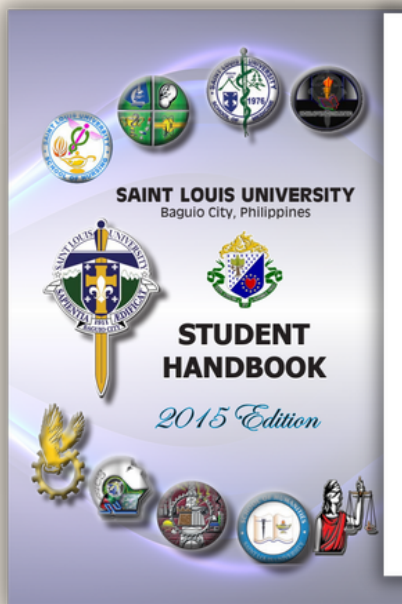

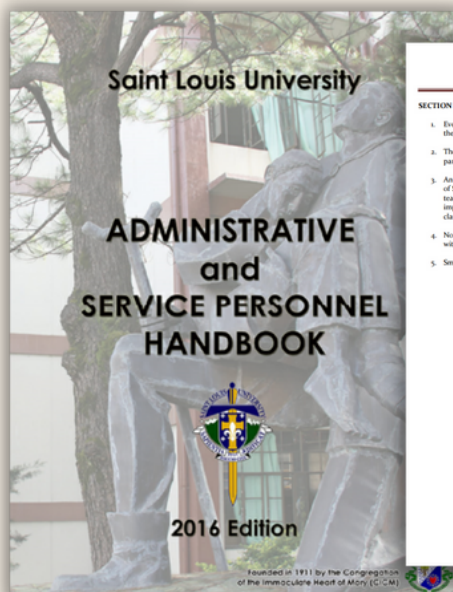


Smoke-free Policy

Saint Louis University issued a message on November 8, 2003, prohibiting smoking by all teachers, staff, and students on campus and in the area in accordance with RA 2911, the "Tabaco Regulation Act of 2003." The implementation guaranteed everyone's welfare and safety as well as the university's commitment to environmental sustainability.



CHAPTER IV CODE OF DISCIPLINE	
2. Using for official school purposes or transaction his/her own ID card which is neither authorized nor valid.	1 st violation – Warning to Reprimand with Confiscation of ID 2 nd violation – Suspension with Confiscation of ID 3 rd violation – Suspension to Non-readmission with Confiscation of ID
3. Unauthorized stay in, or entry to the university campus after 9:00 o'clock in the evening.	1 st violation – Warning to Reprimand / Censure 2 nd violation – Reprimand/Censure to Suspension 3 rd violation – Suspension to Dismissal / Non-readmission
4. Smoking at any time on University premises. (SLU has become NON-SMOKING ZONE under RA 9211 - SLU Memo dated 11/08/2003)	1 st violation – Warning to Reprimand / Censure 2 nd violation – Suspension 3 rd violation – Suspension to Dismissal / Non readmission
5. Littering disposable materials such as but not limited to bottles, cans, pieces of paper, plastic and the like in the classroom, library and other places in the university campus.	1 st violation – Warning 2 nd violation – Reprimand/Censure 3 rd violation – Reprimand/Censure to Suspension
6. Eating inside the classroom during class hours, or in the laboratories or libraries at any time.	1 st violation – Warning 2 nd violation – Reprimand / Censure 3 rd violation – Reprimand / Censure to Suspension
7. Posting, distributing or disseminating notices, posters, leaflets, broadsheets, opinionaires, questionnaires, streamers, popsheets, surveys or similar materials without the prior endorsement of the KASAMA/SSC and approval of the Student Affairs Office.	1 st violation – Warning / Censure 2 nd violation – Suspension 3 rd violation – Suspension to Dismissal / Non-readmission

SECTION VIII. Other Duties and Responsibilities	
1. Every employee is expected to attend meetings duly called for by the University even when these meetings may not be within the eight-hour daily time service.	
2. The employee is expected to join and participate in civic and religious activities sponsored or participated in by the University.	
3. An employee should bring to the attention of the Dean of Student Affairs or Associate Deans of Student Affairs, requests made by students, visitors, or parents for the class schedules of teachers and other students since giving the class schedules himself may be interpreted as an implied permission to enter the classroom - an act which can cause undue interruption of classes.	
4. No employee shall divulge or furnish a copy to a third person any record of the University without the knowledge and written consent of the University.	
5. Smoking anywhere within the University premises is prohibited at all times.
