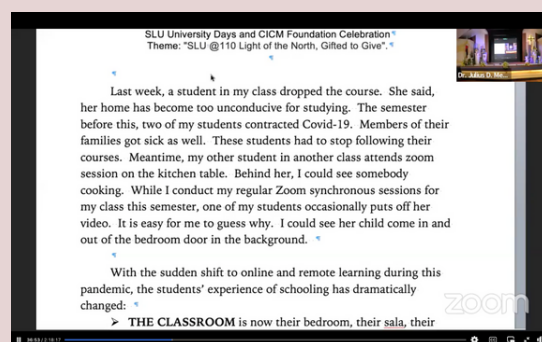
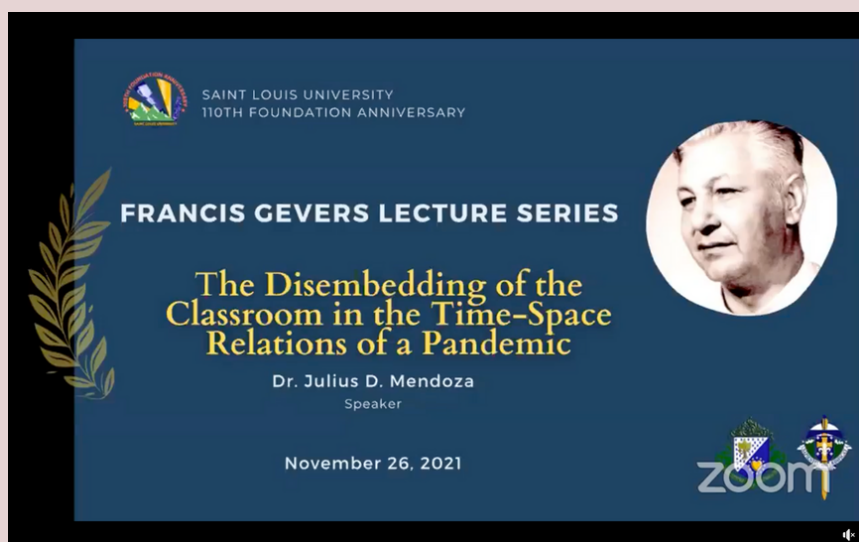

Saint Louis University through the School of Teacher Education and Liberal Arts conducted five-day training sessions for the police personnel of the Police Regional Office Cordillera. The training sessions focused on enhancing the technical writing and speech communication skills of the police personnel. Moreover, the SLU-School of Teacher Education and Liberal Arts in partnership with DOST's recognized Science Teacher Academy of the Region (STAR) resumed its face-to-face training services for all the science and mathematics teachers of the region. This 3-day regional training is intended to enhance the teachers' skills in designing assessment activities for blended learning. As the STAR of the region, STELA continues to support its partners' (DepEd and DOST) advocacy in promoting every learner's mathematical and scientific skills.
