Charles Vath Library, SLU's main library, situated on Bonifacio Street within the SLU Main Campus, was constructed in 1972 as a generous donation from the Zentralstelle fur Entwicklungshilfe of the Federal Republic of Germany and De Rance, Inc. of the United States. It stands as a six-storey building, symbolizing the commitment of the CICM fathers and sisters in providing quality Catholic education to the Cordillera and Northern Luzon communities.
