
The KASAMA/SSC plays a vital role in the promotion of the general welfare and the uplift of the fundamental student rights and duties. It is autonomous and the authority emanates from the students. The SLU KASAMA/SSC is composed of three branches, namely **Executive Committee**, **Student Court and Congress of Louisians**; and two constitutional commissions, namely **Commission on Elections and Commission on Audit**. They have a Constitution and By-Laws that govern their tasks and funding in the form of KASAMA/SSC student fees for their operation and project implementation. The SLU KASAMA/SSC President seats as a committee member in several Administrative Committees whereby student participation is merited.
