This report outlines two significant developments within Saint Louis University (SLU) for the first quarter of 2024-2025. It first details the operational directives and agenda-setting authority of the University Administration Committee, underscoring a robust internal governance framework. Subsequently, it highlights a major strategic external partnership, the Pathways Pilipinas Alliance, which reinforces SLU's commitment to global social responsibility and inclusive education. Together, these initiatives demonstrate the institution's balanced focus on effective internal administration and impactful external engagement.

The internal governance and strategic direction of Saint Louis University are guided by the Administration Committee. This body is tasked with overseeing critical operational, financial, and policy matters to ensure the institution's alignment with its core mission and strategic goals. The Committee serves as a central advisory and decision-making body for non-academic administrative functions. Its purview includes, but is not limited to reviewing and endorsing institutional policies, overseeing budget allocation and fiscal management, addressing facility and infrastructure development, streamlining administrative processes for enhanced efficiency. The Committee's agenda for 2024 focuses on several key institutional priorities. For a comprehensive overview of its current initiatives, meeting minutes, and official directives, the primary repository of records is maintained and accessible through the official SLU administrative channel. In a landmark move to expand its educational mission, Saint Louis University has formally strengthened its commitment to global inclusivity through the Pathways Pilipinas Alliance.

Announced on March 25, 2025, this alliance represents a collaborative effort between SLU and various national and international organizations. The partnership is dedicated to creating and sustaining educational opportunities for refugees and displaced individuals in the Philippines.

Saint Louis University (SLU) welcomed Bicol University Center for Gender and Development officers (BU CGAD) for benchmarking centered on SLU's Gender and Development (GAD) Program, specifically gender mainstreaming. The event was held on 26 September 2024 at the SLU Talged Center.

SLU GAD Committee Chairperson and SLU Office of Student Affairs and Services (OSAS) Director, Ms. Triceayn Marie D. Prestousa, MS Psych, introduced the SLU GAD program. Joining Ms. Prestousa in the discussion were the SLU GAD committee cochairperson, Office for Legal Affairs (OLA) Director, and University Information Officer, Atty. Johanne Margarette Macob; GAD committee member and School of Law (SOL) Dean, Atty. Yasmine Lee R. Tadeo; representatives from SLU Center for Counseling and Wellness (CCW), Ms. Nerisa Gonzalo and Ms. Mary Catherine Pena; SLU Talged Center consultant, Ms. Geraldine Sanil; and SLU Talged Center Assistant, Ms. Justine Latawan. Ms. Prestousa gave a short background on the SLU GAD Program emphasizing that the initial goal of the SLU GAD program is to navigate the role of GAD initiatives in the lives of SLU employees, students, and all stakeholders. The program also raises awareness on gender responsiveness and gender stereotyping.
