

The Msgr. Charles Vath Library, SLU's main library, situated on Bonifacio Street within the SLU Main Campus, was constructed in 1972 as a generous donation from the Zentralstelle fur Entwicklungshilfe of the Federal Republic of Germany and De Rance, Inc. of the United States. It stands as a six-storey building, symbolizing the commitment of the CICM fathers and sisters in providing quality Catholic education to the Cordillera and Northern Luzon communities. The library now hosts a diverse collection of print, non-print, electronic, and internet-based resources and provides free access to the public.

American Corners are venues for learning and programming established in partnership between the U.S. government and hosting educational institutions. They aim to promote understanding and knowledge sharing between the Philippines and the United States. The Philippine network is guided and supported by the U.S. Embassy in Manila. The American Corner Baguio provides access to current and reliable information about the political, economic, cultural education and social life in the United States (US) via book collections, internet, online databases and thought local programming with free access to the general public upon request.





In an inaugural collaboration, Saint Louis University (SLU) and American Corner Baguio (AC Baguio) hosted the American Spaces Philippines Conference 2024 from 2 to 4 October at the Fr. Francis Gevers Hall on SLU's Main Campus.
