

The Museum-Center is the main expression of Saint Louis University's engagement with the Indigenous Peoples (IPs) as a mission priority of the CICM. It has two goals: (1) to preserve and showcase the traditional cultural artifacts and performing arts of the indigenous peoples of the Cordillera region (collectively known as Igorots); and (2) to promote appreciation and understanding of their indigenous cultures and arts. SLU provides free access to museum tours, consultations, and demonstrations upon request, from Monday to Friday. Instructions for the museum access are posted in the SLU Website.

The school was officially inaugurated in 1967 when the College of Arts and Sciences – formerly the College of Liberal Arts founded in 1952 – was split into the Colleges of Natural Sciences and Human Sciences. Rev. Fr. Gerard Braeckman, CICM was at the helm as Dean of this School for more than 30 years, until his retirement in 1998. Most of the collections in the museums were donated by students of the university, benefactors, parents, and other individuals who believe in the objectives and commitment of the museum and the university. The museum usually provides visitors with basic orientation, lectures, and/or demonstrations about the collection. The museum is located at Rizal Building and is open from 10:30-11:30 am every Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday and 1:00-2:00 pm every Thursday, Friday, and Saturday. Free access to the public is provided to the museum.
