

Saint Louis University Pedestrian Priority on Campus





SLU's Safe, Accessible, and Connected Walking Campus

Saint Louis University (SLU) actively prioritises pedestrian access across all its campuses by designing and managing a mobility environment that places walkers' safety, accessibility, and comfort at the centre of campus planning. The University's extensive pedestrian network—mapped across its campuses as shown—features dedicated walking routes intentionally separated from vehicle areas to safeguard pedestrians and promote ease of movement.





SLU's pedestrian pathways are built to be highly inclusive. As shown in the document's photos and descriptions, the University integrates tactile tiles for individuals with visual impairments, ramps and gently sloped walkways for persons with physical disabilities, and covered, shaded corridors that enable safe and uninterrupted walking regardless of weather conditions. These features ensure that mobility on campus supports persons of all abilities and further demonstrate SLU's intentional relocation of parking and vehicular zones away from pedestrian areas, reducing traffic conflict and creating calmer, safer environments for walking. Well-lit walkways ensure safety during evening hours, while wide crosswalks, railings, and barrier-free routes reinforce SLU's pedestrian-first approach.

Police personnel from the Baguio City Police Office provide assistance to students and employees while crossing the streets to ensure safety while going to and from the university. Speed limits of vehicles inside the campus have been limited to 10 km per hour only.
