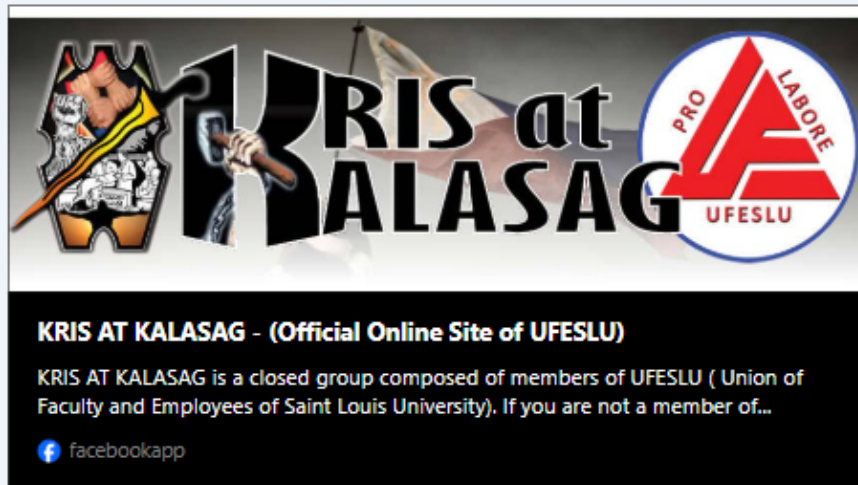

Union of Faculty and Employees of Saint Louis University



Saint Louis University ensures democratic employee representation in institutional governance through the Union of Faculty and Employees of Saint Louis University (UFESLU). The UFESLU President serves as the official employee representative and is elected by co-employees who are not part of the administration, following transparent and democratic processes detailed in the Union's Constitution and By-Laws.

As an active member of key administrative committees, the UFESLU President participates in decision-making processes where employee consultation, feedback, and advocacy are essential. This structure guarantees that the perspectives of non-administrative personnel are formally integrated into University policies and operations, reflecting SLU's commitment to inclusive governance, accountability, and participatory institutional management.

On the other hand, student representation is embodied in the KASAMA/SSSC, SLU's officially recognized student government. Its officers are elected by the student body through a transparent and university-wide electoral process. The KASAMA/SSSC participates in various committees and consultations, ensuring that student perspectives, welfare concerns, and academic interests are incorporated into institutional policies and programs.

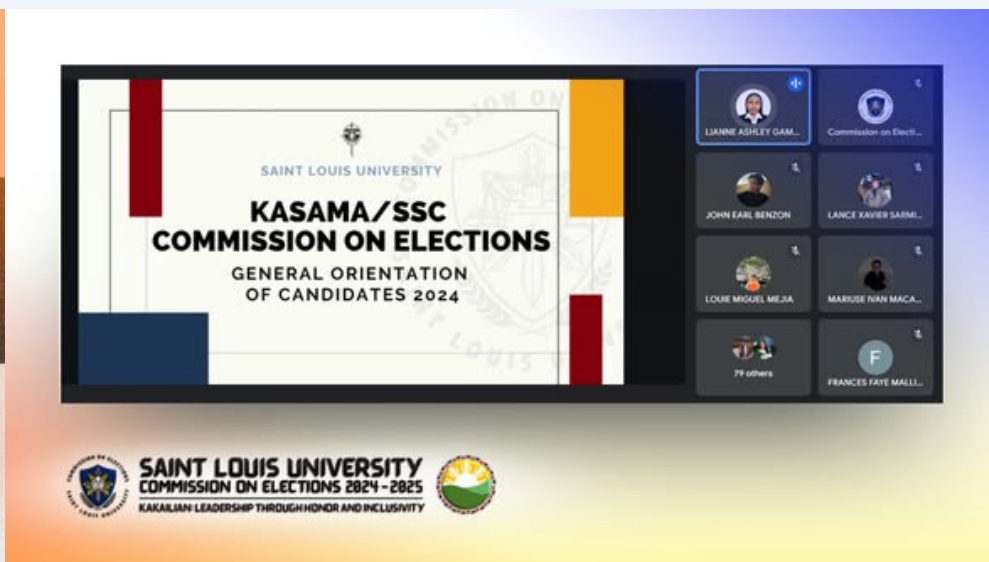
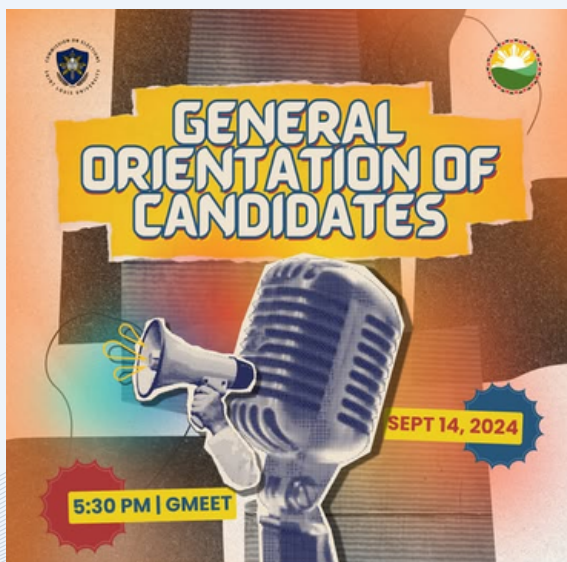
